

Kronenwetter Park Committee Minutes
July 8, 2009

1. Meeting was called to order By Chris Voll at 5:30 PM.
2. Members present were: Deb Shaw, Chris Voll, Carol Osowski, Judy Fries, Rod Fisher, and Jolie Wood. Lucene Udulutch came at 5:40. Guest person was Justine Mallo-Vollrath. Absent was Lisa Myles.
3. Appointment of Park Chairperson and Vice Chairperson- Nominations- motion was made by Jolie and 2nd by Lucene to nominate Judy Fries as chairperson. Motion was made by Rod and 2nd by Deb to nominate Chris Voll as chairperson. Voting for chairperson was done by paper vote. Lucene counted votes. 5 votes for Judy and 2 votes for Chris. Judy Fries is our new Chairperson.
Motion by Judy and 2nd by Lucene to nominate Chris Voll as vice chairperson.
Unanimous by voice vote. Chris Voll is our new Vice Chairperson.
4. Public Input- Justine Mallo-Vollrath Peach Rd. discussed an issue brought up to her by Kronenwetter residents renting out the Friendship Park shelter June 14, 2009 for a 2 family graduation party. Positives- loved the park setting. Issues- where garbage containers are located- could they be moved to another place? Where the garbage containers are currently located, a table could be set there to put food on. Bathrooms- no toilet paper, no paper towels, no soap, no garbage can. (could be because of worry of vandalism). Also the circuit breakers were constantly breaking-fuses blown. The residents wanted to use the faucet by the drinking fountain but were told that they could not use it. They did not get their \$25.00 deposit back because park workers had to move back the garbage containers. Maybe put notes up at park why toiletries are not there because of vandalism going on.
Carol Osowski mentioned that her grandchild enjoyed the Plaza Park facilities.
Judy Fries went to a Marathon County Bike/Pedestrian Committee meeting and discussed actions going on at the meeting. There is a grant of \$10,000 being offered to the committee sometime in the future. Discussion was on having bike racks put in parks. A questionnaire will be given to Marathon County residents concerning biking/walking trails to be used toward the grant. Sometime in 2011 bike trails will be connected to the various municipalities of Marathon County.
5. Park Committee Minutes- Carol made a motion and 2nd by Deb to approve the April and June park committee minutes. Unanimous by voice vote.
6. Treasurer's Report- Lucene made a motion and 2nd by Deb to approve the treasurer's report with a question in regard to the Bike-Pedestrian Set-Aside Fund- money given by the WI Tavern League \$1000.00 on 6/30/2005. Rod Fisher mentioned that it was \$2000.00 given- where is the other \$1000.00?
7. Community Gatherings- no input on festival at Friendship Park- if it was held?

8. Other- Lucene saw some kids sitting on the dugout roof at Sunset Park. She told them to get off which they did. How about getting a sign up by the dugouts saying, "Please keep off the roof". Have to worry about liability.

Carol received a call from Mr. Cywinski (handicapped resident from Kronenwetter) how nice it is that the parks are handicapped assessable.

9. Motion to adjourn was made by Carol and 2nd by Lucene. Unanimous by voice vote.
