

Minutes for Village of Kronenwetter Park Committee Meeting

September 9, 2009

1. Meeting was called to order by Judy Fries
2. Members present were: Judy Fries, Lucene Udulutch, Chris Voll, Deb Shaw, Lisa Myles, and Carol Osowski. Absent were Rod Fisher and Jolie Wood
3. No public input
4. Motion was made by Deb to approve the minutes from August 20, 2009, 2nd by Chris, unanimous by voice vote
5. Motion was made by Chris , to approve the Treasurers report, 2nd by Deb, unanimous by voice vote
6. Judy met with Chief Joling. Police department would like to organize a Parks Watch, with our help. Letters are supposed to be going out, want to be ready for 2010. We discussed how we would handle this. If we have contact with people, they might feel more comfortable talking to us. We will put something in the Winter Newsletter asking for interested people who could help
7. Friendship Park vandalism: The little man and the benches throughout the park were dumped over. No damage was done, but it took 3 guys to put them up again. This happened the night of the board meeting. They are looking for an older guy, with and SUV or van
8. Up date on County Bike and Pedestrian Committee: Judy reported to us about the meeting with Mr. Dennis Helke. Jolie will attend with her next time. They received a grant for \$10,000.00. They will be able to retain an advisor now. She will be contacting all municipalities. State and Federal will be paying for new bike paths, as the laws have changed. Trying to connect Weston to Kronenwetter and Cedar Creek to Kronenwetter. Will have meeting in October, but not November
9. Summer help is done now. Duane got the field sprayer fixed. Rental policy has had wonderful feedback. No new complaints. May be able to rent more at the soccer fields next year. Maple Ridge update: \$450,000 from the DOT, \$300,000.00 from the Village (is part of the TIF district). There will be 2- 12ft driving lanes, an 8ft commuter lane, and then a 9 ft multiple use path. Along the relocated area of Kronenwetter Drive, the DOT will provide a 5 foot paved shoulder, marked for bike routes. Another WPS rep has said yes to using their right away. DOT will design the intersection. Letter will be sent to WPS for confirmation. Mosinee is working with us, and is very supportive. The route will meet up on River RD. Guys have been mowing. General Fall cleanup. Norm Plaza park toilet will be removed. This is a priority
