Magellan Pipeline Company, L.P. (Magellan) is providing the following information related to the recent gasoline release at the Magellan Wausau Terminal located at 2007 Old Highway 51, in the Village of Kronenwetter, Wisconsin. Magellan is dedicated to addressing this release in the most effective and timely manner possible, while maintaining the highest regard for public health and safety.

In early December 2009, Magellan suspected and then validated a leak in a buried pipe within the Terminal and notified the appropriate regulatory agencies. The buried pipe was excavated, replaced with new pipe and permanently moved above ground.

Magellan immediately retained remediation experts to develop and implement an aggressive plan to mitigate impacts to the public and the environment. Magellan has drilled multiple monitoring wells and used groundwater samples to determine that the gasoline plume is located on the terminal property and has not migrated off-site.

Gasoline recovery efforts are underway to ensure that the gasoline does not expand beyond the Terminal property and site remedial technologies are being evaluated to effectively recover the released gasoline as part of a long term remediation system. The remedial efforts will be continuously evaluated and adapted to ensure a timely and successful mitigation of the release. In addition, product and groundwater monitoring will occur on a frequent and regular basis to ensure that current low risk to the health and safety of the public and the environment is monitored and maintained.

Magellan will continue to commit the necessary resources required to mitigate the petroleum-affected soil and groundwater associated with this recent release in accordance with Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) enforcement standards. All work completed at the Wausau Terminal is conducted in compliance with the Wisconsin Administrative Code and under the direct supervision and guidance of the WDNR. The Marathon County Health Department will continue to be involved in the status of site activities as well.

Magellan and the WDNR are working with the Village of Kronenwetter to provide ongoing information to the public.
