KPD ALERT #7: Recent Vehicle Burglaries

The Kronenwetter Police Department and area agencies are again investigating vehicle burglaries, many occurring overnight to unlocked vehicles.

As a reminder:

1) When your cars are parked in an unsecure area (open garage, driveway, etc) keep them locked. Burglars typically do not want to be caught or arouse attention and therefore do not want to break into cars. If your car is secure generally they will move on to the next car hoping it will be unlocked.

2) Keep items of value out of plain view or out of your car altogether. Burglars typically will look in a car before breaking in to see what they might want and they typically do not spend much time in them. If your items are hidden from plain view, the burglar may not enter your car or at least will hopefully miss the item since it is not where they can see it.

3) If your vehicle is unlawfully entered and something is taken, please contact your local law enforcement. When we are investigating these crimes it is helpful to be able to link crimes to a suspect and also recover property & return it to a proper owner when a suspect has been located.
