DRUGS AND WEAPONS SEIZED AFTER DRUG INVESTIGATION

On Sunday March 09, 2008 the Kronenwetter Police Department executed a narcotics search warrant at 2337 Whitetail Drive in the Village of Kronenwetter, at the home of Michael and Angela Grundman. Assisting were the Everest Metropolitan Police Department K-9 Unit and the Mosinee Police Department.

As a result of the warrant officers seized nearly 1.5 pounds of Marijuana, drug paraphernalia, firearms and several thousand dollars in currency.

This warrant resulted after months of investigative work by the Kronenwetter Police Department. As a result of this investigation and the subsequent warrant this department has requested charges from the Marathon County District Attorney on the following:

Michael Grundman (49) & Angela Grundman (43):

Possession with Intent to Deliver THC, Maintaining a Drug Trafficking Place, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Possession with Intent to Deliver w/in 1000 feet of a Village Park (Friendship Park).

Jessica Buck (26):

Felony Possession of THC and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia
