



**EROSION CONTROL FOR HOME BUILDERS**

The Village of Kronenwetter has adopted, as part of its Building Code, the provisions of the Uniform Dwelling Code, Chapter SPS 321 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code. Without limitation by way of enumeration your attention is called to the following construction standards:

*SPS 321.125 EROSION CONTROL & SEDIMENT CONTROL PROCEDURES*

The penalty for any violation of these provisions is set forth in §1.2 of the Village of Kronenwetter Ordinance.

**LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE TO VILLAGE ROADS**

According to Wis. Stats. §86.02 any person who shall injure any road shall be liable for damages. In addition, Village Ordinance §454-18 prohibits filling in of ditches without first obtaining a permit from the Village to excavate, dig upon or in, remove fill or place any tree, object, encroachment or material from, under or in any public street, alley, boulevard, sidewalk or right-of-way within the Village.

I acknowledge and accept responsibility for any damage done to Village roads, either by the owner or any of the owner's contractors.
