EXPLANATION OF BOND SCHEDULE COLUMNS
Information as of January 9th, 2012

1. **FINE RANGE** – This is the range or amount allowed by Ordinance for that particular violation.
2. **STAT./ORD.#** - This stands for “Statute” number which refers to State Law and/or “Ordinance” number which refers to local Village Ordinance number that applies to that specific violation.
3. **DEPOSIT** – This is the amount of the Fine Range that has been approved by the Board as the amount someone can forfeit in lieu of appearing in Court. This is also the amount that is normally levied by the Judge should one be found guilty of a violation of a State Statute or Local Ordinance dependant on circumstances of the case and then becomes the “Fine” amount. The Deposit assigned to violations of State Law is set by the State of Wisconsin.
4. **PENALTY SURCHARGE** – This is currently 26% of the DEPOSIT amount and is collected by the Village and then sent to the State Department of Justice which in turn is used for Law Enforcement Training and related services. There are certain violations that are exempt from this charge such as certain seat belt violations and failure to carry proof of vehicle insurance.
5. **JAIL SURCHARGE** – This is currently a set amount of \$10 for every violation or 1% if over \$1,000 Bond and is imposed regardless of whether or not there is any jail time imposed by the courts. There is NO jail time imposed for Ordinance violations other than possible incarceration as the result of a warrant being issued by the court for failing to pay a fine. This amount is retained by the County to construct, remodel, repair or improve County Jail(s).
6. **CRIME LAB SURCHARGE** – This is a set \$13 amount that is assessed to all Bond Amounts and is collected and sent to the State Department of Justice and is used for Crime Labs and Drug Law enforcement and related services.
7. **COURT COSTS** – This is the amount that is retained by the municipal court for its operation and is set currently at \$28.
