

TREE PLANTING LIST FOR THE URBAN ENVIRONMENT CENTRAL WISCONSIN

Land Management Solutions generally recommends planting of native trees and shrubs suited for and commonly found in that part of the state in which they will be planted. In addition, soils, hydrology and light conditions need to be carefully assessed for each species to be planted. This is a draft document, but listed below are our current recommendations. We also recommend a diversified planting to protect you and your yard from any pest or disease infestation that generally affects a given species. Planting a diversity of stock provides a buffer to this kind of occurrence.

HARDWOODS
